Finally I would like to wish everyone a very merry Christmas and a Happy New Year and I look forward to welcoming you all back in January.



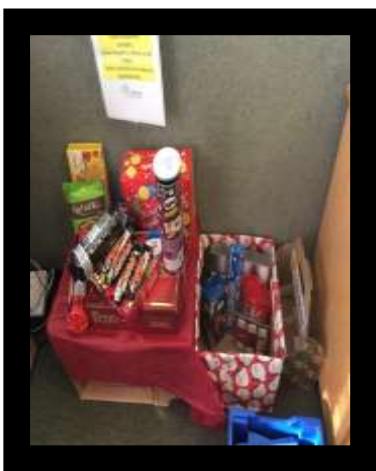
Christmas Carols
